## PURPOSE

The Nathan L. Anderson Memorial Scholarship Foundation was established to honor the life of the late Nathan L. Anderson. In his honor, the foundation provided scholarships to assist minority students pursuing college degrees in areas that were of importance to him.

The purpose of this 501 (c)(3) tax -exempt Private Operating Foundation was to provide scholarship assistance and mentoring career guidance to minority undergraduate college students who pursued training that led to a Bachelor-level degree in one of these four disciplines:

- 1) Computer Science;
- 2) Aviation;
- 3) Nursing;
- 4) Music.
